Connecting to a Computer

Connect the drive to your computer with the cable supplied. The blue LED lights when powered.

Formatting for MAC Computers

NOTE: The drive is factory formatted NTFS for Windows.
 Formatting erases everything on the drive.

To Format for MACs:

1. After connecting, click Initialize in the popup message.
2. Ensure SecureData media is selected and click Erase.
3. Choose a format (Mac OS Extended, APFS, or ExFAT for example).
4. Click Erase.
5. Click Done in the dialog when available.
6. Close the Disk Utility.

Formatting for Windows

To format back to Windows, check our website or look for help on your own system.

Disconnecting and Locking

Unplug the USB cable. The drive locks automatically if encryption was used. Ejecting the drive first is usually not necessary.

Saving Files

Files can now be saved to the drive, for example via File Explorer (Windows), or via Finder (Mac) after formatting; see next heading. New folders can be created as usual.

NOTE: The size of your drive is listed on the packaging that your drive came in. For example, 2 TB.
